In 2004 Hill's Classic Cars was approached by the post master about having a car show to help unveil a new stamp featuring the 55 Thunderbird. It sounded like fun, but we wanted it to be for a good cause. That year we started the scholarship fund as a way to give back to the community and its people. From that first show we awarded \$400 and as of June 2021 we have raised and awarded over \$62,000.

The recipient for this scholarship must be a Meigs County Student graduating from Eastern, Southern or Meigs with a minimum of 1 to be awarded to each High school. The scholarship committee will base the main part of their decision on the essay portion of the application. The 2021 recipients will receive \$1,000 each towards their college expenses.

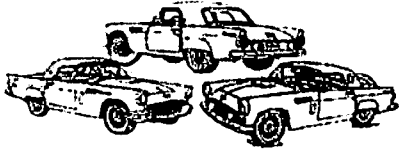

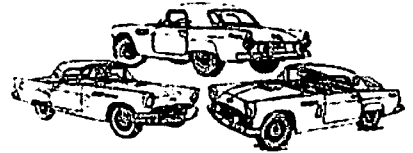
