He was a greatly respected and admired man in the Meigs County Community for his dedication, loyalty, and leadership as an educator, leader, and teacher. He was an inspiration to all who knew him personally and professionally.

Mrs. Nan Moore

Mrs. Nan Moore was born October, 1900. She was a Middleport High School graduate of 1919. She attended Ohio Wesleyan University and received her elementary certificate from Akron University. She received her degree from Ohio University in 1933. She taught Middleport High School for twenty-seven years and retired in 1964. Mrs. Moore was active in many community and church affairs. She too, was an inspiration to all those lives she touched.
