

Meigs High School Summer School 2020 Information

DATES: Monday, June 1st – Friday, June 26th.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: 2:00PM on Friday, May 29th.

ELIGIBLE STUDENTS: Meigs High School students who have failed a class for a semester or for the year.

CLASSES OFFERED: Any eligible class through Virtual Learning and MHS curriculum. Courses are for credit recovery purposes only.

COST: \$130.00 dollars for a 1-credit class, \$65.00 for a semester class.

OVERVIEW: Summer school is an opportunity for students to make up class credit. In the time frame listed above, students will work with the teacher and VLA to show mastery of the class. Students are expected to work diligently and make reasonable progress each day toward mastery of the subject. Students have achieved success in summer school because they set a goal, had a responsible attitude, and worked to accomplish the requirements for mastery.

PAYMENT: Payment is due prior to the student beginning their coursework. Checks are to be made payable to “Meigs Local School District.” Students will not receive credit until the Summer School bill is paid in full. ATTENDANCE: **Due to COVID19 there will be no in person attendance.** Students must have internet access in order to complete summer school assignments. There will be a WiFi hotspot available to summer school students at MHS. Students are expected to **SUBMIT ASSIGNMENTS DAILY** until they have completed their course work for full credit.

COMMUNICATING WITH TEACHERS: Teachers will be available to answer student questions through the messaging feature in their Virtual Learning Academy account. Teachers will answer messages between 8:00AM and NOON Monday through Friday during the Summer School session.

CREDITS: Credit will only be given when all work is complete. A final grade communicated to students at the end of the summer session. The current school grading scale will be used for accreditation. Deadline for all credit-recovery work is as soon as possible and all work *must* be completed by the last day of summer school. **Assignments submitted after June 26th will not be graded.**

DISCIPLINE: Students are expected to follow all school rules. If student conduct is severe, students will be removed from the summer school program immediately. If someone other than the student completes the work, or if a student is removed from the summer school program, credit will not be given.

SUMMER SCHOOL APPLICATION

Students are eligible if they are Meigs High School students and have failed the class for the year. For entry to MHS Summer School 2020, students and parents must sign this form and return it to the MHS Office. Signing this form means that students and parents/guardians have read and agreed to the rules and procedures of this program.

You will receive your account log-in, password and instructions from the school counselors once your payment has been received.
